

There are many types of teachers who join Prince Edward Island Registered Music Teachers' Association (PEIRMTA):

- Private music teachers who have a degree or diploma in music and teaching experience
- College and university professors of music
- School music teachers
- Specialists in early childhood music education
- Student teachers who have attained at least a grade 9 or 10 level and are continuing their education

All active members of the PEIRMTA are automatic members of the Canadian Federation of Music Teachers' Association (CFMTA). A portion of the annual PEIRMTA provincial membership fee is designated as the CFMTA annual membership fee. One benefit of CFMTA membership is access to liability insurance coverage. Visit www.cfmta.org for further information on CFMTA.

REINSTATEMENT AND TRANSFERS

Reinstatement: If you have previously been a member of PEIRMTA, you do not need to provide any further documentation except a written request to the PEIRMTA Registrar. If your membership has lapsed for more than 5 years, you will be required to remit the \$20 Registration Fee, along with your Membership dues.

If you wish to be reinstated with registered subjects that are different than, or in addition to, those recognized in your original membership, you will need to submit a new application along with supporting documentation for those subjects.

Transfers: If you are currently a member of another Canadian Registered Music Teachers' Association, you can have your membership transferred by requesting that your provincial administrator send PEIRMTA written confirmation of your membership in good standing, along with the registered subject(s) associated with your membership. No further documentation is required. You still need to complete the Member Application Form, and you will be required to remit the \$20 Registration Fee, along with your Membership dues. Please contact the PEIRMTA Registrar (registrar@peirmta.ca) before beginning the regular application process.

LIABILITY INSURANCE:

Liability Insurance is provided for each member and is included in the membership dues. This provides \$5,000,000.00 coverage for claims (due to injuries) which may arise from music teaching and related activities occurring in the teacher's home-based studio or on the premises. Members are also covered for activities performed outside of the home as they act in the capacity as members of the PEIRMTA.

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

Registered Music Teacher (RMT)	 Uses RMT designation Votes at Provincial Association meetings Includes Conservatory Associateships, and those with degrees such as Bachelor of Musical Arts, Bachelor of Music, Master of Music, Doctor of Music, and those accepted as members by the Provincial Association. These could include experienced teachers who are deemed equivalent by the provincial Membership Committee. They have met <u>all</u> criteria set out by the PEIRMTA
Affiliate Member (All Levels)	 This category includes experienced teachers who are deemed equivalent by the provincial by-laws. They have <u>not</u> met all criteria set out for full provincial RMT membership. Affiliate Members will be categorized in one of the three Affiliate Member Levels (as outlined below). The category placement depends on the requirements outstanding for full membership. Allowed to vote but not to hold office nationally. May hold office locally and/or provincially. Will receive Canadian Music Teacher newsletter Not entitled to use RMT designation
AM1 Affiliate Member Level 1	 Completed Grade 10 Conservatory with all theory OR École de musique Vincent d'Indy Neuvième Année – Laureat II
AM2 Affiliate Member Level 2	 Completed Grade 9 Conservatory with all theory OR École de musique Vincent d'Indy Septième Année - Supérieur II
AM3 Affiliate Member Level 3	Other as determined by the Membership Committee
Auxiliary Member	 Supports goals of the Association but does not teach. Does not use the RMT designation after his/her name. Does not vote at Provincial Association meetings This category could include individuals such as retired music teachers, music publishers, owners or managers of music stores, music librarians, instrument technicians, representatives of music festivals, music students and other supporters of music Does not include CFMTA membership; not eligible for Liability Insurance
Life Member (LM)	 May be granted upon the recommendation of the Executive Council to those who have rendered meritorious service All provincial dues, and insurance if required, for Life Members shall be paid by the PEIRMTA
